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FIREARM SIGN/INFORMATION

_____ (A) "IF YOU KEEP A LOADED FIREARM WITHIN ANY PREMISES UNDER YOUR CUSTODY OR CONTROL, AND A PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE OBTAINS IT AND USES IT, RESULTING IN INJURY OR DEATH, OR CARRIES IT TO A PUBLIC PLACE, YOU MAY BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR OR A FELONY UNLESS YOU STORED THE FIREARM IN A LOCKED CONTAINER OR LOCKED THE FIREARM WITH A LOCKING DEVICE, TO KEEP FROM TEMPORARILY FUNCTIONING." **Penal Code 12071(b)(7)**

_____ (B) "IF YOU KEEP A PISTOL, REVOLVER, OR OTHER FIREARM CAPABLE OF BEING CONCEALED UPON THE PERSON, WITHIN ANY PREMISES UNDER YOUR CUSTODY OR CONTROL, AND A PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE GAINS ACCESS TO THE FIREARM, AND CARRIES IT OFF-PREMISES, YOU MAY BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR, UNLESS YOU STORED THE FIREARM IN A LOCKED CONTAINER, OR LOCKED THE FIREARM WITH A LOCKING DEVICE, TO KEEP IT FROM TEMPORARILY FUNCTIONING." **Penal Code 12071(b)(7)**

_____ (C) "IF YOU KEEP ANY FIREARM WITHIN ANY PREMISES UNDER YOUR CUSTODY OR CONTROL, AND A PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE GAINS ACCESS TO THE FIREARM, AND CARRIES IT OFF-PREMISES TO A SCHOOL OR SCHOOL-SPONSORED EVENT, YOU MAY BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR, INCLUDING A FINE OF UP TO FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000), UNLESS YOU STORED THE FIREARM IN A LOCKED CONTAINER, OR LOCKED THE FIREARM WITH A LOCKING DEVICE." **Penal Code 12071(b)(7)**

_____ (D) "DISCHARGING FIREARMS IN POORLY VENTILATED AREAS, CLEANING FIREARMS, OR HANDLING AMMUNITION MAY RESULT IN EXPOSURE TO LEAD, A SUBSTANCE KNOWN TO CAUSE BIRTH DEFECTS, REPRODUCTIVE HARM, AND OTHER SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY. HAVE ADEQUATE VENTILATION AT ALL TIMES. WASH HANDS THOROUGHLY AFTER EXPOSURE." **Penal Code 12071(b)(7)**

_____ (E) "FEDERAL REGULATIONS PROVIDE THAT IF YOU DO NOT TAKE PHYSICAL POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM THAT YOU ARE ACQUIRING OWNERSHIP OF WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER YOU COMPLETE THE INITIAL BACKGROUND CHECK PAPERWORK, THEN YOU HAVE TO GO THROUGH THE BACKGROUND CHECK PROCESS A SECOND TIME IN ORDER TO TAKE PHYSICAL POSSESSION OF THAT FIREARM." **Penal Code 12071(b)(7)**

_____ (F) "NO PERSON SHALL MAKE AN APPLICATION TO PURCHASE MORE THAN ONE PISTOL, REVOLVER, OR OTHER FIREARM CAPABLE OF BEING CONCEALED UPON THE PERSON WITHIN ANY 30-DAY PERIOD AND NO DELIVERY SHALL BE MADE TO ANY PERSON WHO HAS MADE AN APPLICATION TO PURCHASE MORE THAN ONE PISTOL, REVOLVER, OR OTHER FIREARM CAPABLE OF BEING CONCEALED UPON THE PERSON WITHIN ANY 30-DAY PERIOD." **Penal Code 12071(b)(7)**

CA DOJ FEES

_____ List of CA DOJ Fees:

DOJ Dealer Record of Sale (DROS) Processing Fee of \$19, *dealers shall not misstate or misrepresent the DOJ fees.*

DOJ Safety and Enforcement Fee of \$5

DOJ Firearm Safety Device Fee of \$1

DOJ Reduced DROS fee of \$15 (\$19 total) per additional handgun for multiple handgun transactions

Dealer Fee (which shall not exceed \$10 per firearm) for processing a private party sale or transfer

If applicable, all fees associated with the Handgun Safety Certificate (HSC) program including:

DOJ \$15 HSC certificate fee (if applicant completes/passes the objective test)

Dealer fee (which shall not exceed \$10) for administering the HSC objective test. *The total for administering the test and issuing the certificate shall not exceed \$25 .*

DOJ fee of \$5 for the HSC video

DOJ fee of \$.50 for the HSC workbook

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NON-CA DOJ FEES

- _____ List of non-CA Fees (subject to change at any time):
 - \$10 FFL Private Party Transfer Fee per firearm
 - \$50 FFL non-Private Party Transfer Fee for first handgun, \$45 for each additional, processed at the same time, some limitations apply to handgun transfers. Buyer may be required to provide a dummy round or empty brass for firearm safety demonstration
 - \$45 FFL non-Private Party Transfer Fee for first Long gun, \$35 for each additional, processed at the same time.
 - \$20 discount per firearm with proof of membership in a firearms rights organization, such as the NRA or GOA.
 - \$25 Order Fee, only applies to FFL ordered firearms, per firearm, plus costs.
 - \$15 minimum shipping fee
 - \$20 "dirty gun" fee (ie. Cosmoline), any firearm which requires special handling/cleaning

_____ Storage Fees:
 \$10/day, per item, for each item left for 30 days or more, charged from the first day. There is no storage charge for items picked up in under 30 days. Other storage by prior arrangement.

_____ Late Fees:
 All business is done by appointment. If you are late for an appointment by over 15 minutes, there will be a charge of \$60/hour, with a minimum charge of \$15.

_____ Firearm Lock/Gun Safe:
 A CA approved firearm lock is required for all firearm transfers, unless you have a safe or lockbox which meets the CA requirements. Proof of purchase is required, date within 30 days of pickup, and customer is responsible for purchasing an approved device.

OTHER

_____ As required by law, you can purchase a CA gun law pamphlet at the time of sale or transfer of a firearm. The cost is \$2 per copy. It is available online at no cost. Do you wish to purchase the gun law pamphlet? Yes _____ No _____

_____ As required by law, there is a 10 day waiting period (ten 24 hours days starting when the DROS is submitted) for most firearms transfers, therefore your firearm may have to be stored. There is no charge for the storage (unless left over 30 days) nor is there insurance for stored firearms, therefore you assume all risks in such storage. If you are not willing to assume the risk, please use another firearms dealer.

_____ Any firearm left for over 45 days (total) will be considered abandoned and will become the FFL's property. This and any storage charge may be waived by advance agreement or under unusual circumstances with independent verification. The reason for this is to strongly encourage the prompt pickup of all items.

_____ All sales are final and there are no refunds on special orders unless approved in advance.

_____ Payment is to be check or cash at the start of the waiting period and only cash at the time of pickup, with a minimum payment of expenses at or before the paperwork is started..

_____ Customer is responsible for any and all collection/attorney charges/fees/expenses related to this transaction. The FFL is providing the transfer service as a public service, at a minimal cost, which does not typically cover the expenses.

_____ Any false information given by the customer or any indication that the transaction might not be legitimate will cause the cancellation of the transaction and the customer is liable for any and all expenses related to the transaction, as well as relinquishing all rights and interest in the firearm involved.
